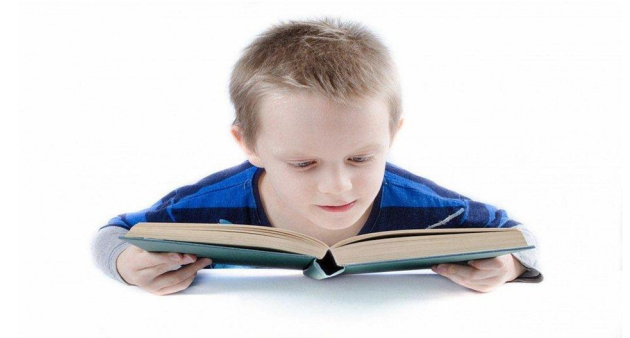

Social Services have said that your child can't live with you for now. The court is deciding what is best.

If your child does not live with you they will not know very much about you.

All children want to know about their parents, even if they do not live with them.

We can tell them about you, if you like.

We can meet with you and you can tell us about yourself. You can give us photos. We can help you write a letter.

We will tell the people who are looking after your child about you.

We can speak to other people in your family if you like. Your child will be interested in finding out about their other relatives.

We will not tell social services what you say to us unless you tell us that you or someone else has been hurt or is going to be hurt.

You can choose if you want to talk to us or not.

Other people say that talking to us is helpful.
